

The individual feedback of candidates as taken On behalf of GSF Shri Prabhakar Vishnu, State Head Grameen Sneh Foundation DDUGKY Project Meghalaya undertook the task of onsite verification of candidates placed in Chennai. The biggest achievement of this verification was that all the 30 candidates were found to be in very high spirits with good job satisfaction and desire to move on. The candidates were all praise for GSF for from their employers was quite positive and encouraging for GSF barring a few candidates.

Sanctioned and approved by the end of 2021, the Grameen Sneh Foundation (GSF) DDU-GKY (Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana) remained in slumber for more than a year for unknown reasons by PBSSD (Paschim Banga Society for Skill Development) and finally after tireless efforts by GSFians the project took off and the Training Centre was established in Siliguri (Darjeeling District). Post establishment of the Training Centre, Due Diligence approval the GSFian West Bengal team started the Mobilization of candidates for the said project from Darjeeling, Kalimpong and Uttar Dinajpur districts. Right mobilization of candidates is a very crucial step in the DDUGKY



program implementation. It involves reaching out to potential candidates and encouraging them to participate in the skill development and livelihood generation program in Hospitality Sector. The GSFian Mobilizers targeted Rural youth, typically between 15-35 years old with focus on disadvantaged sections including women, SC/ST, minorities of Darjeeling, Kalimpong and Uttar Dinajpur districts. 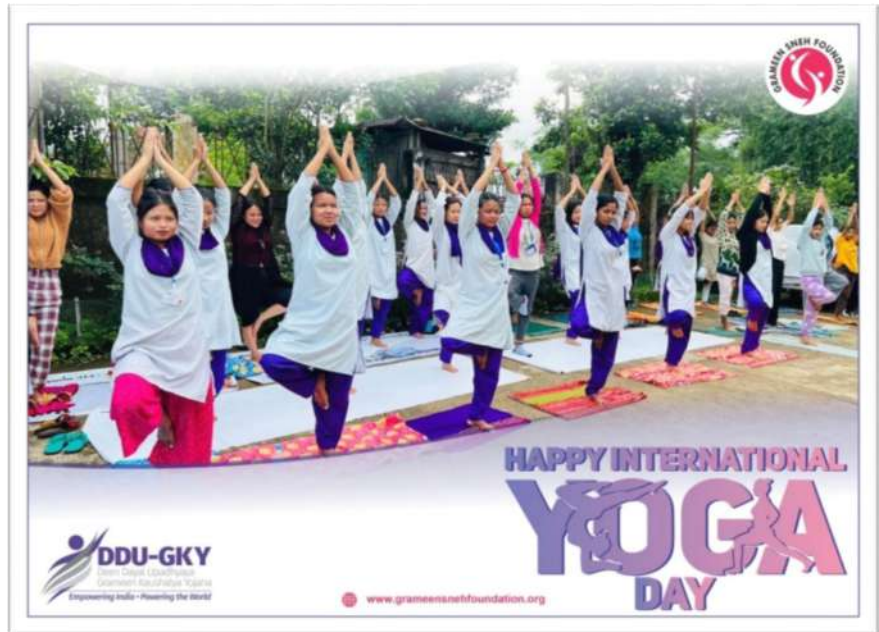

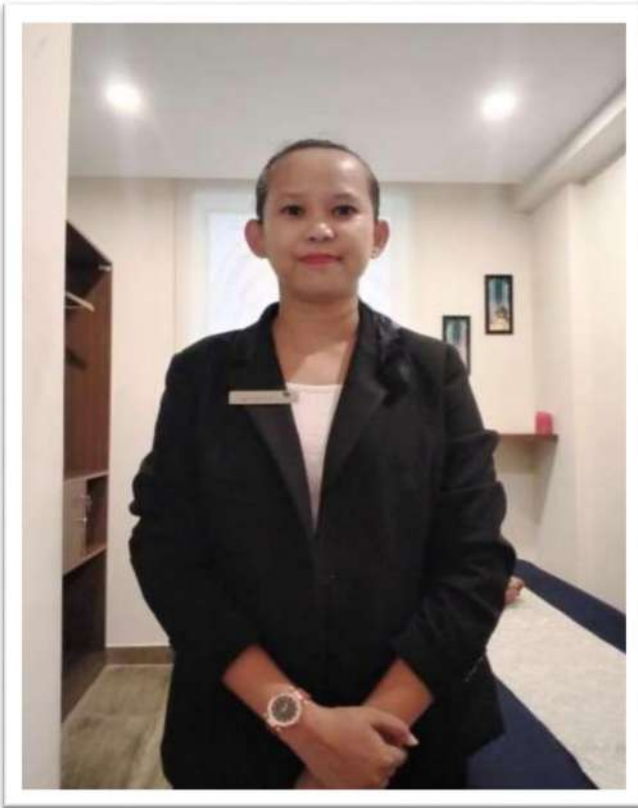
